

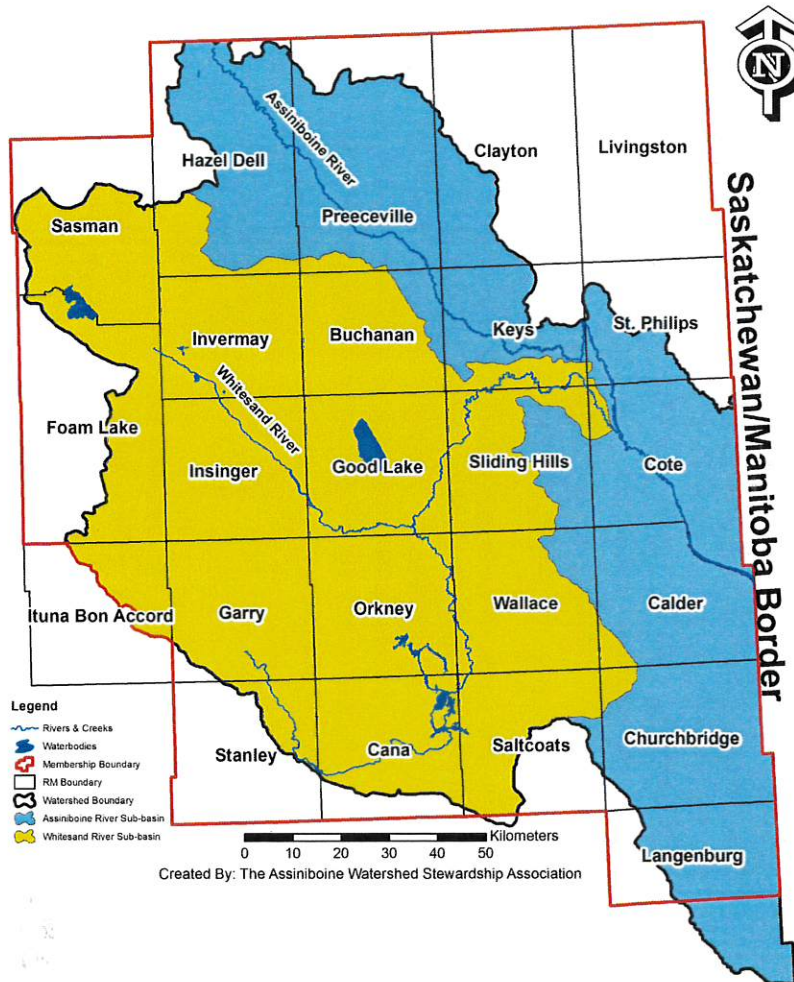

- I am a producer located within the mapped boundary
- I have a Premise Identification number for any livestock on my property
- I am planning on completing one or more of the following Beneficial Management Practices (BMPs)

OR

- I have completed one or more of the following Beneficial Management Practices (BMPs) since October 1, 2017:

- Decommissioning abandoned wells*
- Constructing or expanding a dugout
- Drilling a new well
- Converting cropland to permanent forage*
- Converting cropland to permanent native rangeland*
- Variable rate mapping
- Fencing to manage the riparian area*
- Fencing to manage rangeland grazing*
- Targeted grazing for biocontrol of invasive plants*
- Erosion control for drainage works*
- Multi-producer drainage operations*
- Relocating of livestock to protect groundwater*
- Improving manure storage*
- Livestock nutrient management planning*
- Carcass disposal*
- Livestock run-off control*

**These BMP's now require pre-approval - call us before starting any new projects.*

If so, the Assiniboine Watershed Stewardship Association may be able to obtain funding to assist you with these BMPs by providing Agri-Environmental Technical Services.

These BMPs not only improve your current operations, they minimize negative environmental impacts and therefore help to protect our water resources.
