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OWNER/AGENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The owner of each building in Saskatchewan shall ensure that the building is designed, constructed, altered, repaired, or renovated in accordance with "The Uniform Building and Accessibility Standards Act" of Saskatchewan.

BUILDING PERMIT

- Owner/agent must submit the required drawings to the R.M. Office for review by the Building Official.
- Owner/agent must submit approval from Public Health for the septic system to the R.M. Office before a building permit can be issued.
- The R.M. will issue a building permit when the above requirements have been met and the inspection fees have been paid.

INSPECTION SCHEDULE

- A "required inspection" schedule will be provided by the building official. Please insure that contractors and sub-contractors receive a copy of this schedule.
- A minimum of forty-eight hours notice will be required for inspection requests.
- Failure to have a required inspection done may result in a "stop work" order being issued. This could result in delays in construction and additional inspection fees being charged.

PLUMBING INSPECTION

- Public health requires that septic systems be inspected before back fill.
- All interior plumbing rough-in must be inspected.
- Owner/agent shall insure that tank installers and plumbing contractors have the required inspections completed.
